The Uilenburgersjoel is an historic monument that was build in 1766 as synagoge for Jewish religious services in. During the following 175 years the building was in function as a synagoge in the Jewish quarter on Uilenburg, a small island within the old city. It is one of the few remaining original buildings on the island that has been preserved. After the second world war the building was used for different purposes, since almost the entire jewish population of Uilenburg was deported and murdered in WWII. At the start of this century the City of Amsterdam handed over the sjoel to the Stichting Uilenburgersjoel. This foundation brought the building back to live: it was restored in its original state with some modern adjustements. Now this beautiful old synagoge is a cultural meetingplace for a variety of meetings and events.






Spaces: Synagogezaal/Synagogehall

The beautiful old Synagogezaal can be used for all kinds of meetings or events. There are no fixed chairs in the hall or on the balcony's, so the hall is flexible in set up. The monumetal wooden pillars and the magnificent blue-green half round wooden ceiling underline the historic character of this stunning restored synagoge. With great acoustics, abundant daylight and natural beauty this charming hall gives a head start in atmosphere, style, look and feel to any event.

Spaces: Grachtenzaal/Canalroom

De Grachtenzaal is situated on the ground floor, right underneath the Synagoge hall. This hall, with a view over the Uilenburgergracht, can be divided with a sliding wall. Spaces: Tuinzaal/Gardenroom

Our new Gardenroom is a lovely place for smal or mediumsize meetings. This reconstruction of the original shed, will be finished in the summer of 2024 en consists of a completely new 60 m² space that can be divided into two parts by a sliding wall in the middle. Under the old Maple tree, right next to the entrancegates and right in front of the Synagoge, the Gardenroom can be used as a separate space, but also as an extra space for breakouts during an event in the main building. The Gardenroom has its own pantry, toilet and av equipment.

Accessibility

The Uilenburgersjoel is accessible for people that are less mobile or for people that use a wheelchair. The side entrance of the building provides direct acces to the Grachtenzaal, the elevator and wheelchair toilet. The elevator stops on the mezzanine where the main entrance is, and on the first floor, the entrance to the Synagoge hall. The elevator does not reach the balcony's of the Synagoge hall.

Cars of people using wheelchairs can be parked on the courtyard.

Public Transport

The sjoel is located in the heart of old Amsterdam, close to the Waterlooplein, the Nieuwmarkt and the Damstraat. Tram 14, Metro 51 from Amsterdam central station wil take you tot the Nieuwe Uilenburgerstraat within 5 minutes.

Tram 14: stop Waterlooplein, Metro 51: stop Nieuwmarkt.

On foot

Take a 10 minute walk from Centraal Station over the Damrak to the Dam. Walk throught the famous Damstraat. At the end turn right at Joodenbreestraat, go over the bridge on your left and you are on Uilenburger Island.

There are several parkings close to the sjoel.





acces to Uilenburgergracht





Synagogezaal first floor


